


Kenya Challenge

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Kenya Challenge Badge

We have put together this fun Challenge Badge to assist our Young Leader, Felicity, fundraise for her Volunteer Trip to Kenya in the Summer of 2014. We hope you enjoy this challenge.

We suggest that to get the badge;

- Rainbows do 1 activity from each section,
- Brownies complete 1 from each section plus 1 more from any section
- Guides and Senior Section do 1 from Travel section and 2 from each of the other sections.

Activities from different sections may be combined...

Section 1 - TRAVEL

1. Make a passport and decorate a stamp for it. Know why you need a passport to visit other countries
2. Make a postcard from a place you have visited and add a short description on the reverse.
3. Know which countries you would need warm clothes and clothes for hot countries. Know how to protect yourself against the sun rays.
4. Draw a picture of a Rainbow, Brownie or Guide uniform from another country. Compare what is the same, and what is different from your own.
5. Make up a game that could be played whilst travelling.



Section 2- ANIMALS

1. Make an Animal mask. Play games with an animal theme.
2. Find out what animals, birds and reptiles can be found in a National Park in Kenya. Discuss with your Unit which is your favourite, or make a model of it in any material.
3. Find out all you can about an endangered animal and make a poster or leaflet about it.
4. Visit a Zoo or adopt an animal
5. Hold a Pets evening and raise money for an Animal Charity of your choice.



Section 3- WATER

1. Keep a record for a week of the water you use. And list ways of using less.
2. What would you miss using clean water for if ours was rationed to a set amount per day and how is water sourced when there is no running water in the home.
3. Know how to keep safe when near rivers canals and the sea and what to do in an emergency.
4. Know how to clean your teeth and wash hands correctly and why clean water is important.
5. What is Water Aid? Find out what they are doing in Kenya and have a fund raising evening to support it.



Section 4- KENYA

1. Draw the Kenyan National Flag.
2. Find out about the history of Guiding in Kenya and see if you can find the Guiding Promise and see how it differs from yours.
3. Find out about the culture and hold a Kenyan evening and taste food from Kenya.
4. Find out about Fair Trade, know the problems of transporting food from a distance, and make a list of food products from Kenya that can be found in our shops.
5. Find out the connection that Lord and Lady Baden Powell and the Queen have with Kenya and write a short speech about this.
