



RIKKI AWARD 2017

The 'Rikki' Award is open to all members of the Senior Section, either as individuals or as a group of 2 or more. A trophy is awarded to the winning entry as decided by independent judges. UK - India Year of Culture

2017 is the date of a year-long programme of events to celebrate UK's cultural ties with India and to celebrate the 70th anniversary of Indian independence. The Year of Culture 2017 will see an exciting festival of events celebrating the vibrant cultural history of the 2 countries.

Your mission:

- Create a Bollywood-style mini-film.
- Create your own waxwork model to celebrate the feature in Madame Tussauds in New Delhi. Visit Madame Tussauds in London.
- Visit 'Sangam' – either for real or in your own Unit.
- Birthdays are the big celebration in India. Create a 'Celebration of India' - to include culture, food and dress - in a format of your choosing.

Consideration will be given for creativity in interpreting these challenges.

You can undertake more than one of these challenges and integrate 2 into 1. In the event of more than 1 challenge being undertaken, the judges will decide on the best single challenge (in their opinion) in selecting a winner.

You will need to record your challenge/project so that it can be seen by the judges – in a format of your choice. Remember that the judges like to be entertained too!

Entries must be sent to Rikki or the County Office to reach them by no later than midday on Friday 16th June 2017.

The winners each year must return the trophy to Rikki by no later than the closing date for entries the following year.
