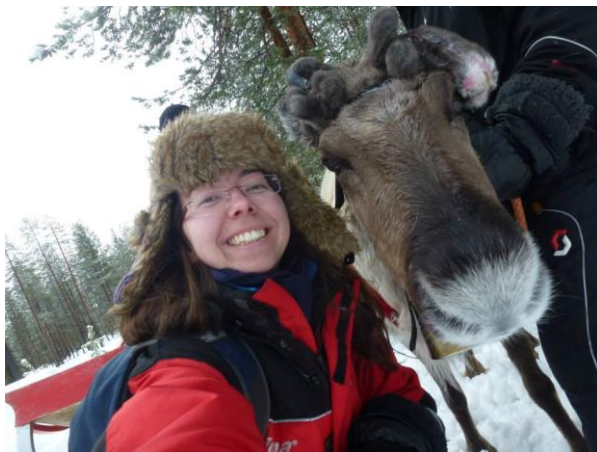


Finland 2015
