BE BRILLIANT Challenges

To achieve the "**Be Brilliant in Buckinghamshire**" challenge badge, girls must complete the **Main Challenge** plus a specific number of additional activities based on their section. Remember to take photos and share with other groups. (Check photo permissions are in place.)

The Main Challenge

- Find out about your [District, Division, or County Banner](#).
- Discover what the emblems represent, when the banner was made, and what it is made of.
- If possible, have the banner visit your unit meeting and create a picture, collage or mosaic replica of it.

Section Requirements

- **Rainbows:** Main Challenge + **4** further activities.
- **Brownies:** Main Challenge + **5** further activities.
- **Guides & Rangers:** Main Challenge + **6** further activities.

B	Badge	Pick one Interest Badge from your handbook to start this month and complete it this term.

U	Under the Stars	Go stargazing and find the North Star or a famous constellation.	
C	Chilterns	Learn one fact about the Chiltern Hills or the local Red Kite population.	
K	Kindness	Perform a "Random Act of Guiding Kindness" for someone in your community.	
I	Industry	Discover what was historically made in your part of Bucks (e.g., chairs, lace), or what it was/is famous for.	
N	Notable Women	Research a famous woman from Bucks (like Roald Dahl's Miss Honey types or the codebreakers of Bletchley Park..	
G	Give	As a unit collect for the food bank or a local charity shop.	
H	Heritage	Visit a local landmark, Blue Plaque, or a historic church in your area.	
A	Artistic	Draw, paint, or photograph a beautiful view of the Bucks countryside.	
M	Moving	Walk, cycle, or scoot to your next meeting instead of using a car.	
S	Spell it out	With your unit, can you spell out 'Bucks' and send a photo in to the county office to use for social media	
H	Helping Hand	Teach a younger member a new skill, like tying a knot or a campfire song.	
I	Investigate	Find out the names of other Girlguiding Units in your District, Division or County. How many can you name?	
R	Red Kites	Spot a Red Kite soaring in the sky (the unofficial mascot of Bucks!) How many facts can you find out about the Red Kites
